Inflation

The rising cost of goods and services, including food, healthcare, and housing, is draining household incomes.

Financial Assistance

Benefits for food and other services are dwindling + the working poor cannot qualify for funding.

Food Supply

Due to increased food prices, food banks and food pantries are unable to keep up the surge in demand.

We meet people when and where they are to be a food resource to all.

Meanwhile, **38% of the US food supply goes to waste.**
That's approximately 100 billion pounds of food a year.

Food Decomposition

Food waste in landfills breaks down quickly and releases methane gas that contributes to global warming.

Energy

All of the energy that goes into our food is wasted if the food is thrown away. This energy can instead fuel someone's potential.

Food Rescue

Rescuing unsold food is a natural solution to food waste. Using it to feed neighbors in need is a double benefit.

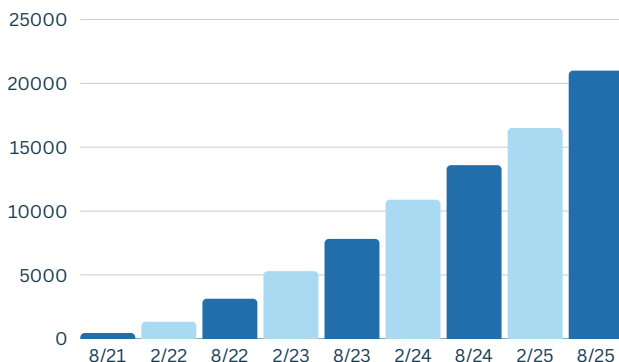

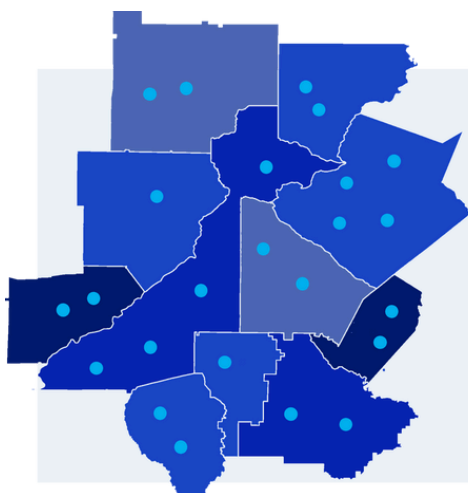

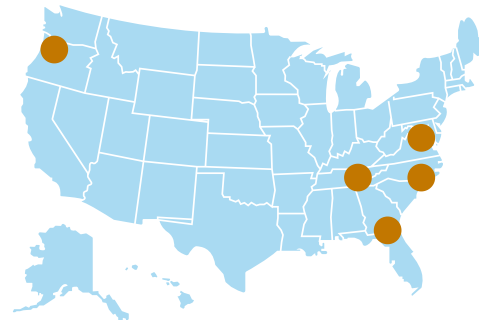
